RECENTLY, SCIENTISTS HAVE DEVELOPED THE "MICRO CIRCUIT".NOW A COMPUTER CAN BE AS SMALL AS A CIGARETTE PACKET. THE COMPUTER CIRCUITS ARE PRINTED ON VERY SMALL PIECES OF SILICON, AND LATELY PEOPLE HAVE MADE LITTLE COMPÜTERS TO PUT INSIDE YOUR TELEPHONE OR GAS STOVE. THE COMPUTER SWITCHES THE GAS STOVE ON OR OFF, OR CHANCES THE PHONE-CALL TO A DIFFERENT NUMBER.

#### **SUBWAYS**

THE PARIS"METRO" IS NEARLY AS OLD AS THE LONDON UNDERGROUND, BUT IT IS NOT AS BIG.

THE MOSCOW SUBWAY IS THE MOST ELEGANT IN THE WORLD.IT HAS STATIONS AS BEAUTIFUL AS FALACES.THE FASTEST SUBWAY TRAINS IN THE WORLD ARE IN SAN FRANCISCO; THEY TRAVEL AT 140 KILOMETERS PER HOUR.THE TOKIO SUBWAY IS THE MOST CROWDED IN THE WORLD, BUT THE MÉXICO CITY METRO IS NEARLY AS CROWDED.
