COMPUTERS .

MAN HAS USED COMPUTERS FOR ABOUT THIRTY YEARS. NOW, HE HAS USED THEM TO COUNT MONEY, TO SOLVE MATHEMATICAL PROBLEMS, TO SEND SPACECRAFTS TO THE MOON... AND TO FIND HUSBANDS AND WIVES FOR PEOPLE.

AT FIRST COMPUTERS WERE VERY BIG AND DIFFICULT TO OPERATE. THE OPERATOR PUT CARDS WITH INFORMATION INTO THE COMPUTER AND THE COMPUTER PRINTED THE ANSWER OR SOLUTION ON A SHEET OF PAPER. BUT SINCE 1960 . OPERATORS HAVE USED TAPES AND DISKS IN COMPUTERS AND THEY HAVE ASKED THE "QUESTIONS" ON A KIND OF TYPEWRITER. (YOU CAN SEE THEM IN BANKS AND AIRLINES OFFICES).

RECENTLY, SCIENTISTS HAVE DEVELOPED THE "MICRO CIRCUIT". NOW A COMPUTER CAN BE AS SMALL AS A CIGARETTE PACKET. THE COMPUTER CIRCUITS ARE PRINTED ON VERY SMALL PIECES OF SILICON, AND LATELY PEOPLE HAVE MADE LITTLE COMPUTERS TO PUT INSIDE YOUR TELEPHONE OR GAS STOVE. THE COMPUTER SWITCHES THE GAS STOVE ON OR OFF, OR CHANGES THE PHONE-CALL TO A DIFFERENT NUMBER.

SUBWAYS

IN MANY BIG CITIES IN THE WORLD THERE ARE SUBWAY SYSTEMS. FAST TRAINS TAKE PEOPLE FROM ONE PART OF THE CITY TO ANOTHER. THE TRAINS USUALLY TRAVEL UNDER THE STREETS IN THE CITY CENTERS, SO IT IS MORE CONVENIENT AND FASTER TO TRAVEL BY SUBWAY THAN BY BUS OR TAXI.

THE OLDEST SUBWAY SYSTEM IN THE WORLD IS THE LONDON UNDERGROUND ("THE TUBE"). IT BEGAN IN 1890, AND IT IS ALSO THE MOST EXTENSIVE SYSTEM IN THE WORLD WITH 279 STATIONS.



THE PARIS "METRO" IS NEARLY AS OLD AS THE LONDON UNDERGROUND, BUT IT IS NOT AS BIG.

THE MOSCOW SUBWAY IS THE MOST ELEGANT IN THE WORLD. IT HAS STATIONS AS BEAUTIFUL AS PALACES. THE FASTEST SUBWAY TRAINS IN THE WORLD ARE IN SAN FRANCISCO; THEY TRAVEL AT 140 KILOMETERS PER HOUR. THE TOKIO SUBWAY IS THE MOST CROWDED IN THE WORLD, BUT THE MÉXICO CITY METRO IS NEARLY AS CROWDED.

MÉXICO CITY SUBWAY TRAINS HAVE WHEELS MADE OF RUBBER AND SO THEY ARE THE QUIETEST SUBWAY TRAINS IN THE WORLD. THE MÉXICO CITY SYSTEM IS ALSO ONE OF THE MOST MODERN SYSTEMS AND THE CHEAPEST IN THE WORLD.
